Peddler, Solicitor, Canvasser Permit Criteria

1. Applicant must furnish a valid government issued identification which includes a photograph of himself/herself.
2. Applicant cannot have any theft convictions within the past two years.
3. Applicant cannot have any felony convictions within the past three years.
4. Any sex offense is grounds for automatic refusal of a permit.
5. Any outstanding warrants, including misdemeanor traffic warrants, must be cleared before a permit will be issued.
6. A criminal history of repeated violence or recent violence (within 5 years) is grounds for automatic refusal of a permit.
7. A criminal history of repeated alcohol/drug abuse is grounds for automatic refusal of a permit.
8. Any person holding a current peddler, solicitor, canvasser permit who violates any of the above criteria shall have their permit revoked.
